

Raw stone



Comb hammer

This object is handmade from natural stone. The most commonly used stone is soapstone, which comes in various hardnesses and colours. Stone is a natural product in which irregularities occur. The handwork, the character of the material and the diversity of colours make each sculpture unique.

The stone is shaped with hammers, chisels, rasps and files. Finally, the sculpture is polished and, under heating, a wax layer is applied. The wax layer enhances the stone's patterns, but it is also vulnerable.

We advise you to handle the sculpture with care, as rings and nails can scratch and damage the wax layer, revealing the original colour of the stone.

Should the sculpture become dull over time, you can polish it with clear wax.

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
